- 12-101 Charlotte McDermott asked if we need all this insurance since we have not had any claims. Highlighted that the vast majority of the increase is on the property.
- 4-105 Rick Marini asked about dropping hurricane insurance and self-insuring. He also suggested hiring an independent insurance broker to assess our policies.
- 5-311 Robert J. Gentile asked about being over insured. He also suggested cutting cable out. That is not possible because it is in our documents that we must provide basic cable. A letter will be coming out soon in regards to changing cable companies. He also felt the pool redo was expensive. He asked about cutting back to one maintenance person during off season.
- 2-203 Vince Narolis asked about how we financed the insurance. He also inquired

about new coupon books for increased monthly fee. JoAnn said they will be printing new ones if the amended budget passes. You may not receive them before July 1, 2023. The additional payment should be added to the current rate if amended budget passes.

- 6-204 David Rubio suggested requiring another assessment instead of increasing the monthly fees. He also asked about hiring an insurance consultant. He also questioned the pool cost. He asked if we received interest on our reserves. Response: Yes.
- 12-101 Charlotte McDermont asked if there is a charge to the office for new coupon books. Yes, there is but it is minimal. The change is done automatically if you use ACH.
