- 1. Shutters are to be the roll-up or accordion horizontal type.
- 2. Slats are to be aluminum.
- 3. Kevlar Screens are allowed as long as they are white.
- 4. All materials, except screws, nuts, bolts, etc. are to be white.
- 5. All screws, nuts, bolts and anchors to be aluminum or stainless steel.
- 6. Lanai shutters require inside installation existing screen enclosures.
- 7. Shutter installation to comply in accord with Florida State Building Codes (8th Edition or higher). A permit is required as per Collier County Permitting Department. The office of Turtle Lake Golf Colony requires a copy of the permit before installation.
- 8. Shutters are to be as those manufactured by Rolsafe, Roll Secure or approved equal.
- 9. Externally installed shutter hood design to be five (5) sided and to have cast aluminum end caps with .032" or aluminum brake metal covers.
- 10. All requests for shutter installations must be made, in writing using a unit alteration form, to the Association's Board of Directors for approval. Installation is not to begin without written approval from the Association Board of Directors to the unit owner.
- 11. Drainage (scuffer) holes are to be made on the shutter tracks to promote drainage.
